

Where Is JACR Online?

A recent survey of ACR members revealed a common question: “Is the journal available online?” In response, we’ve prepared step-by-step instructions to help you access *JACR* online. One of the big advantages of online access is that it provides you more options for saving articles. Rather than ripping articles out of the magazine, you can save them electronically as PDF files so that you have permanent access to them. Additionally, it is very easy to share an electronic file with a colleague.

To get started, follow these instructions:

1. Go to the ACR Web site — www.acr.org.
2. Click on the Login button on the ACR Home Page (under the “About Us” bar). To log in, you will need your:

- **Username:** your first and last initials, lowercase, followed by your eight-digit membership number
- **Password:** your last name, lowercase with no punctuation or spaces

After you have logged in, scroll down the page until you see a *JACR* cover along the right side. Listed below the cover are three bars labeled “View Current Issue,” “Search Archives,” and “Subscribe.” Clicking on any of these bars will take you to *JACR*’s home page (www.jacr.org), hosted by Elsevier, where you will see a screen that shows the cover of the most recent issue of the journal. 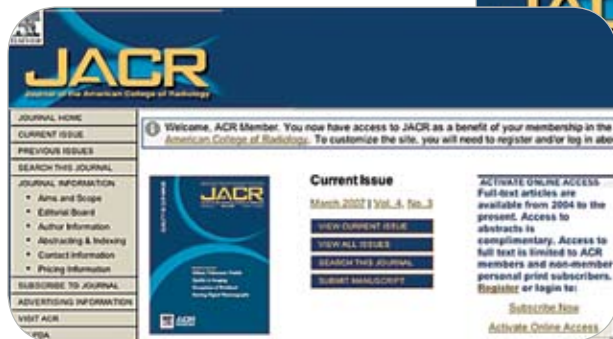

VIEW CURRENT ISSUE

Click on this bar to bring up articles in the current issue. Articles appear in order, with the title, author, and page numbers listed. You can open, save, or print an article in either a text or PDF version. You can also e-mail an entire article to a colleague or simply export and save citations of articles that interest you.

VIEW ALL ISSUES

When you click on “View All Issues,” you will have access to the full text and abstracts of every issue. Every article is available from

the years 2004 through the current issue in 2007. You may then open, save, print, or e-mail articles along with saving citations of articles that you may want to read later.

SEARCH THIS JOURNAL

When you click on “Search This Journal,” you will see the screen shown in Figure 2. Under the drop-down “Search” menu, you can choose to search by title, author, full text, abstract plus citation, citation, or by all fields. You may also include the volume, issue, start page, or dates to help define the search. Your search results can be sorted by relevance or by date. You may search by specific periodical titles, by all periodicals listed, or by MedLine.

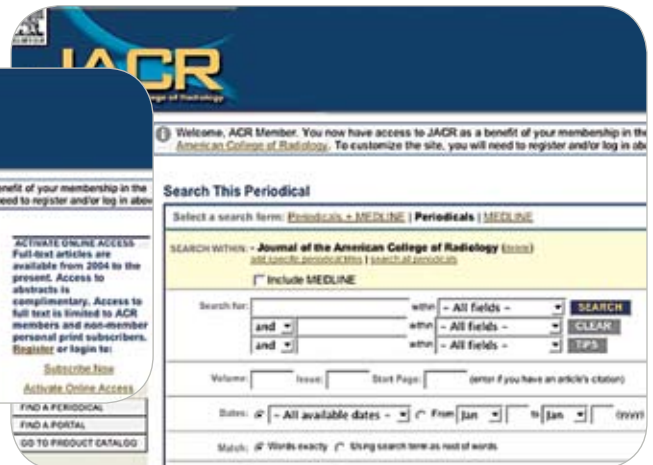

SUBMIT MANUSCRIPT

The last choice on the *JACR* home page is to “Submit Manuscript.” This takes you directly to the journal’s online submission and editorial system where you can log in to submit a manuscript for publication or track a submission already in progress.

The home page of www.jacr.org contains other pertinent information about the journal that you can access, such as editorial board contacts, instructions for submitting a manuscript, contact information, and pricing information for subscriptions, advertising, and reprints.

From the home page of www.jacr.org, you may return to the ACR home page by clicking on “Visit ACR.” For electronically advanced members, click on “My PDA.” Here you can arrange to receive the journal via PDA by registering on www.pocketconsult.com. ■
