

Access the *JACR* Online

Follow these directions to gain access to the *JACR* Web site:

1. Go to the ACR Web site — www.acr.org
2. Scroll down until you see a cover of the *JACR* underneath “Inside the *JACR*,” which is located below the menu on the left-hand side. Within that box, select “Current.”
3. Log in to the ACR with your:
 - a. **Username:** your first and last initials, lower case, followed by your eight-digit membership number
 - b. **Password:** your last name, lowercase, with no punctuation or spaces. Passwords must be at least six characters long; if your last name is fewer than six characters, add a “9” for each additional space necessary to total six characters.

4. Select “View Current Issue of *JACR*”
5. You’ll be taken to the *JACR* Web site, where you can either view the current issue or select “Previous Issues” from the menu to review past editions.

Searching the *JACR*

While you are on the *JACR* Web site, you can search the entire journal, including past issues. Simply select “Search This Journal” from the menu on the left-hand side of the *JACR* Web site. In the new screen, use the drop-down menu to choose whether you’d like to search by title, author, full text, abstract plus citation, citation, or all fields. You can also include the volume, issue, start page, or dates to help define the search.

Submitting Your Manuscript to the *JACR*

Do you have a white paper or other manuscript that you’d like to submit to the *JACR* for consideration? If so, click on “Submit Manuscript” from the menu on the left-hand side of the *JACR* Web site. This takes you directly to the journal’s online submission and editorial system. From here, select “log in” or “register” from the menu at the top of the page in order to submit or track your manuscript.

You’ll also find resources to help you in your submission, including a “Guide for Authors,” a “Tutorial for Authors,” and more, all through the editorial system. If you have technical questions about submitting a manuscript, review the options under the “Support and Training Information” menu.
