Talk with you ahead of time

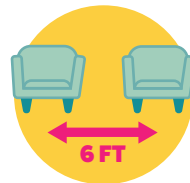


Limit the number of exams that day

Give you a mask

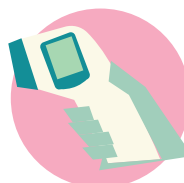


Practice social distancing
