Dr. Carr is Professor Emeritus of Management and Accounting at Babson College. He has taught in the Graduate School of Business and continues to work in Babson Executive Education. His courses included Managing and Achieving Strategic Results, Managing and Measuring Performance and Strategic Cost Management. He has served as Dean of the graduate school and Coordinator of the MBA integrated curriculum. He has received the Kennedy Award for teaching excellence in the graduate school and the dean's award for teaching excellence at Executive Education. Dr. Carr has published over 35 articles and 15 teaching cases. He is co-author of Total Quality Management: A Cross-Functional Perspective; Guide to Cost Management; and Delivering Results: Managing what Matters. He has been published in Management Accounting, Journal of Cost Management, Strategic Performance Measurement, International Journal of Strategic Cost Management, and Sloan Management Review.

Prior to his academic career, Dr. Carr spent 18 years in industry. For eight years he was Division Controller and Vice President for Kollmorgen Corporation, a publicly held diversified electronics company. He served as President and CEO of OSRAM, Corp., the U.S. and Canadian subsidiary of Siemens for 8 years. During that time he developed and managed the dramatic growth (32% + CAGR) of this lighting company. He led the corporation as it established distribution systems and centers, developed a manufacturing facility in the United States, and introduced new product lines to the market.

Dr. Carr's areas of research include multinational transfer pricing, and activity-based management and performance measurement. He consults in the areas of implementing strategy, management control systems, performance measurement and strategic cost systems. His clients include Fortune 50 firms, other publicly traded companies and privately held corporations. He serves on several boards including Union Graduate College.
