The RLI Health Care Economics Milestones (HCEM) Program provides a unique, interactive experience for residents to gain knowledge of radiology health care economics and, at the same time, satisfy the ACGME systems-based practice competency requirement.

### How the Program Works:

The program is organized into five blocks to address the five milestones. During each block, residents will go through a heavily interactive and engaging educational experience to ensure deep learning and comprehensive understanding of the topics and their practical application in today's radiology reality.



#### WHAT IS THE TIME COMMITMENT?

The program runs for seven months and is carefully designed to work around busy resident schedules so as to not interfere with other duties and coursework.
