

No Surprises Act (NSA) Implementation

Working with its physician organization colleagues to encourage Congress to scrutinize diligently the administration's implementation of the NSA and ensure it adheres to the original intent of Congress — to provide an equal playing field for both providers and insurers to resolve their disputes while taking patients out of the middle.

Research Policy

Advocating for NIH biomedical research funding during the congressional appropriations cycle. ACR has met with NIH and HHS leaders to advocate for medical imaging inclusion and increased prominence in the president's Cancer Moonshot initiative.

Scope of Practice (SOP)

Tracking SOP legislation in 38 different states and Puerto Rico that have the potential to directly impact radiology.

Medical Policy Review

Reviewing and commenting on Medicare, Medicaid and Private Payer coverage policies relevant to radiology through its various networks (Carrier Advisory Committee, Medicaid and Payer Relations).

AI Innovation

Working with federal government agencies to advance safe and effective AI innovation and represent end-users' perspectives and clinical needs.

Patient Access
